For advertisers wishing to approve a proof, the deadline is Friday, seven days before publication.

Circulation Information: Average press run: 900 in winter & 1,200 in summer. THE SKAGWAY NEWS serves Skagway, Alaska, which has a year-round population of more than 900 residents. In the summer months (May-September) Skagway's population is approximately 2,500, hosting more than 900,000 tourists. The newspaper is sold at news dealers in Skagway, Haines and Juneau, Alaska and in Whitehorse, Yukon Territory, where the Whitehorse Star prints it. It is mailed to about 550 subscribers from Skagway to Sweden.
